Some sports have finished up and some are starting after winter break. 8th graders took the Pre-ACT on Monday, all feeder schools take it to help sort out support/staff for the incoming freshman. Staff vs 8th grade basketball game is this Friday afternoon. The hiring committee for the principal position scheduled 3 interviews with candidates, 2 canceled for various reasons so only 1 interview was conducted. Jocelyn reported about the Vilas County Bike Trail trying to connect their trail; they will be presenting options to the Board at the next Board Meeting. All area superintendents have been contacted by the YMCA that is planning to come to Woodruff to see how the schools can be a part of it. 3 grade levels (K, 1st, 7th) projects were chosen by EL to have in their "warehouse" as excellent showcases of work.
